Meeting Agreements

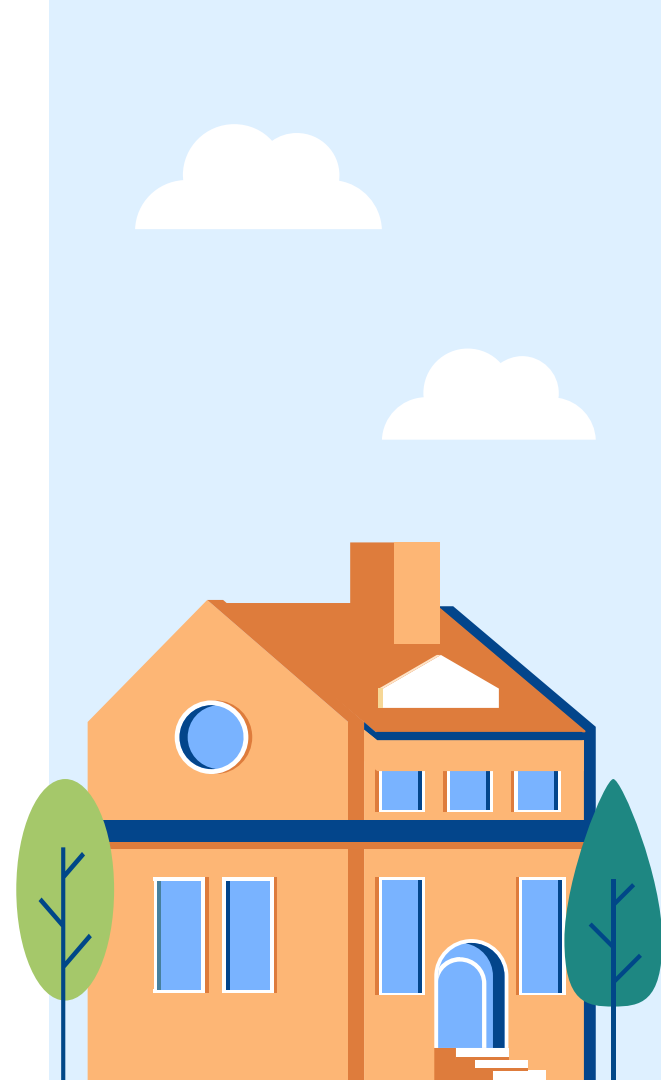
- **Assume Positive Intent** - We are all doing the best we can with what we have, avoid blaming others.

2026 Landscape

Elections - 2026 is a heavy election year. Noteworthy elections:

- Congressional District 18
 - January 31, 2026 - Fill late Sylvester Turner spot
 - March 3, 2026 - Primaries begin for midterms
- County Judge
- County Attorney
- County Commissioner
- Governor, Lt. Governor
- Senator (John Cornyn's seat)
- All 150 State Representatives





2026 Landscape

There are significant projects happening in and around the East End. I have tried to document them all:

- McKinney Sidewalk Project - 6 months, starting in March (EED)
- Fourcade/Dumble Sidewalk Project - start date TBD, 60% design (EED)
- Telephone Road Redesign - Fall 2026 (TIRZ 23)
- East End RAILS Study (Pct 2)
- Leeland/Cullen Grade Separation Study (TIRZ 24)
- Western Gateways Study (EED)
- Public Safety Improvements (2026) - Navigation, Harrisburg corridors (EED)
- Eastwood Park - Phase 1 Implementation (TIRZ 23)
- George R Brown Convention Center Expansion (Houston First)
- Polk St official closure (Houston First)
- NHHIP 45 Realignment (drainage work) - big dig starts in 2027
- Reimagine Milby (Pct 2)
- West Belt Improvement Project Phase 1 (2029)





2026 Landscape

In listening to feedback from previous years, these are the most common challenges residents face (in no particular order):

- Train blockages and noise
- Public safety - speeding cars in neighborhoods, gunshots
- Equity in mobility - safe sidewalks and streets for all types of transit
- Loose dogs
- Lack of green space, parks, tree-planting and addressing illegal dumping
- The unhoused population - treating with fairness and humanity
- Presence of ICE in the neighborhood
- Trash and recycling pickup
- Presence of ICE in the neighborhood
- Proactive communication about projects and initiatives by the city

(we will get feedback in a moment about this)

- Transportation Advocacy (Chair: Lisa Hunt)

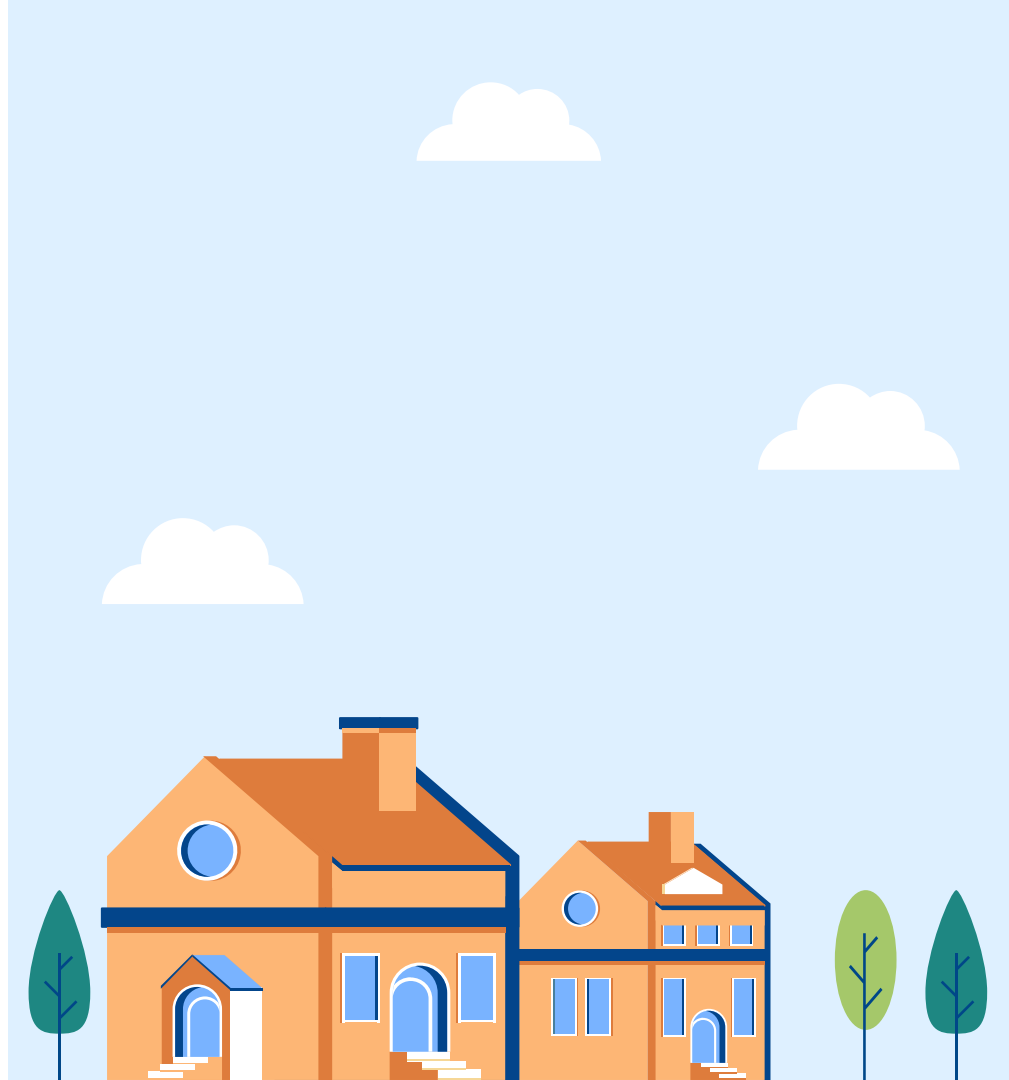
We have shared these committees with District I so we can align on goals.

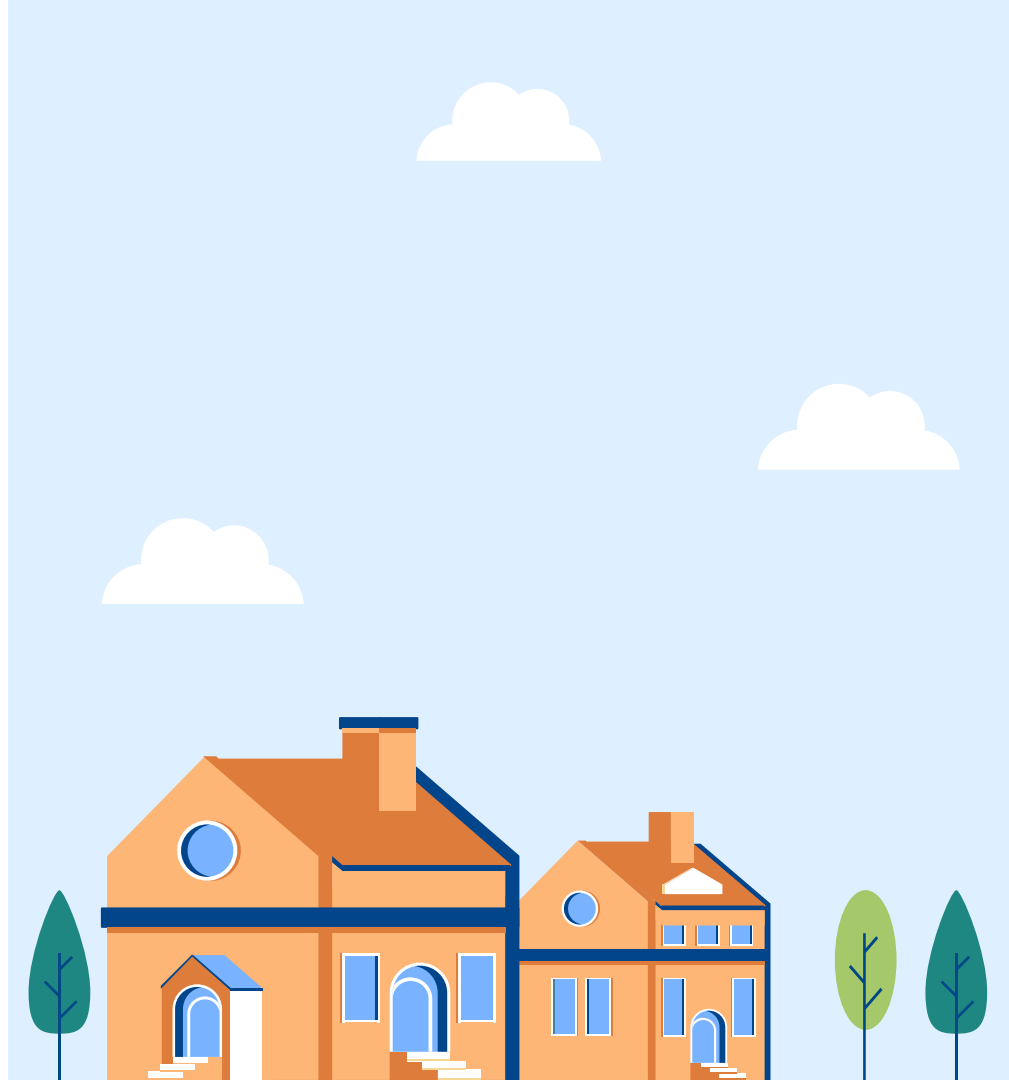

2026 Officer Elections

We will be holding officer elections on February 28, 2026. The positions are:

- President
- Vice-President
- Secretary
- Treasurer

These are two year terms. You will need to be able to commit to ~5-10 hours per month to meetings and events with the Super Neighborhood

If you want to be elected into one of these positions, you will need to meet the following criteria:

- You need to live or work within the Super Neighborhood boundaries
- You need to have attended at least 2 meetings in the past 12 months

To run, you will need to come to the February 25, 2026 meeting, you will be given a chance to introduce yourself (1-2 min), and we will hold a vote.
